Drawing from the case file and interviews with the families of survivors, Baran argues that what happened in Bila Tserkva demonstrates the sheer ambition of the state's plans for the Sovietization of borderland communities. A compelling history, *To Make a Village Soviet* looks to Bila Tserkva to explore the power and the limits of state control – and the possibilities created by communities that resist assimilation.
