For a long time, the study of the life and work of the Jewish thinker Ibn Kamm?na (d. 683/1284) remained limited to a very small number of texts. Interest in Ibn Kamm?na in the Western Christian world dates back to the 17th century, when Jean Barthelemy d'Herbelot (1624-1695) included information on two of Ibn Kamm?na's works - his examination of the three faiths ("Tanq al-ab th li-l-milal al-thal?t"), i.e. Judaism, Christianity and Islam, and his commentary on Avicenna's "al-Ish?r?t wa al-tanb?h?t" - in his "Bibliotheque orientale." Subsequent generations of Western scholars were focused on Ibn Kamm?na's "Tanq al-ab th," whereas his fame in the Eastern world of Islam was based exclusively on his philosophical writings. These include a commentary on the "Kit?b al-Talw t" by the founder of Illuminationist philosophy, Shams al-D?n al-Suhraward? (d. 587/1191) and numerous independent works on philosophy and logic. Since most of the manuscripts of Ibn Kamm?na's philosophical writings are located in the public and private libraries of Iran, Iraq, and Turkey, they were (and are) out of reach for the majority of Western scholars. The volume gives a detailed account of the available data of Ibn Kamm?na's biography, provides an outline of his philosophical thought and studies in detail the reception of his thought and his writings among

Muslim and Jewish philosophers. An inventory of his entire oeuvre provides detailed information on the extant manuscripts. The volume furthermore includes edition of his writings. In late nineteenth century Lucknow, two rival story-tellers, Syed Muhammad Husain Jah and Ahmed Husain Qamar, wrote a fantasy in the Urdu language whose equal had not been heard before, and which has never been rivaled since. It was called Tilism-e Hoshrubah. The writers claimed that the tale had been passed down to them from story-tellers going back centuries: it was a part of the beloved epic, The Adventures of Amir Hamza which had come to the Indian subcontinent from Persia and had gained in popularity during the reign of Akbar, the Mughal emperor. Tilism-e-Hoshrubah is the subcontinent's first wholly indigenous Indo-Islamic fantasy epic. It tells the stories of Amir Hamza's military forces, his grandson and his loyal army of tricksters (masters of wit and disguise) as they go to war with Afrasiyab, the tyrant who rules the magical land of Hoshrubah. Fantasy, the occult, adventure and romance play themselves out in a typically Indian setting as wizards, sorceresses, tricksters and royalty pitch themselves into the battle for Hoshrubah. The characters of the epic are marvels of literary creation, and are much more colourful and dashing than those of the Amir Hamza cycle of tales. The Tilism-e Hoshrubah runs to twenty four volumes and will be translated into English for the first time ever by Musharraf Ali Farooqi, the author and translator of The Adventures of Amir Hamza. Random House India will publish all the volumes starting with Hoshrubah: The Land and the Tilism, i.e. Book 1 of the series. Includes entries for maps and atlases. Situating Nima's life firmly within the context of 20th century Iranian history this book contributes to an emerging trend in literary scholarship on Persian literature that views Persian poetry as a living and constantly evolving tradition rather than an icon of some fading glory.
