He examines Abbey's childhood roots in the East and his love affair with the West, his personal relationships and tempestuous marriages, and his myriad jobs in continually shifting locations—including sixteen national parks and forests. He also explores Abbey's writing process, his broad intellectual interests, and the philosophical roots of his politics. For Abbey fans who assume that his "honest novel," *The Fool's Progress*, was factual or that his public statements were entirely off the cuff, Cahalan's evenhanded treatment will be an eye-opener.
